1. The father is filled with compassion for his son. 2. He runs to him – in those days it was very undignified and shows his great desire to welcome him home. 3. He hugs and kisses him – showing his love and welcome. 4. He doesn't let him finish his speech. 5. Immediately restores him to the position of son. 6. A great feast. Jesus wants his listeners to understand that the amazing father in the story is a picture of God. Isn't that amazing!

The son recognised he had sinned, and sort forgiveness. When we recognise we have sinned against God, we can go to Him and find forgives through Jesus (because of His death and resurrection).

Say some prayers of thanks to God the Father. You could write or draw them and stick them up around the house to remind you to thank God for who He is and what He has done.
