## Craft 1: Fruity people

You will need: small paper plates; cocktail sticks; chunks of various fruits from around the world, such as kiwi fruit, mango, melon, banana and pineapple

Working on a paper plate, make a person by using the cocktail sticks to connect various chunks of fruit together.

Which country does each fruit you have used comes from? Do you know anything interesting about any of these countries?



## Activity 1: Good News whispers

You will need: some 'good news' messages about Messy Church or something that has happened recently, for example: 'Messy Church is great fun for all the family.'



Sit in a circle. Whisper a good news message to the next person, who should then pass it to the next person in the circle by whispering, and so on. The last person should call out what they heard. See how accurately it

compares to the original message!

## Craft 2: String of doves

You will need: dove template; world map template; pencils; scissors; hole punch; string



Draw round a dove template on to the world map template and cut it out. Punch a hole in the neck of your dove and tie a piece of string through the hole.

Our doves are made from maps of lots of different countries to remind us that when the Holy Spirit came at Pentecost the disciples spoke in many different languages so that people from different countries could understand them.
