## Jesus meets 10 lepers - Luke 17:11-19

<sup>11</sup> As Jesus continued on toward Jerusalem, he reached the border between Galilee and Samaria. <sup>12</sup> As he entered a village there, ten men with leprosy stood at a distance, <sup>13</sup> crying out, "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us!"

<sup>14</sup> He looked at them and said, "Go show yourselves to the priests." And as they went, they were cleansed of their leprosy.

<sup>15</sup> One of them, when he saw that he was healed, came back to Jesus, shouting, "Praise God!" <sup>16</sup> He fell to the ground at Jesus' feet, thanking him for what he had done. This man was a Samaritan.

<sup>17</sup> Jesus asked, "Didn't I heal ten men? Where are the other nine?" <sup>18</sup> Has no one returned to give glory to God except this foreigner?" <sup>19</sup> And Jesus said to the man, "Stand up and go. Your faith has healed you."

Only one of the ten lepers Jesus healed, came back to give thanks for the new life they had received. People who had leprosy (a skin disease) had to live away from other people; they were outcast. They couldn't spend time with their families, they could work, they were isolated from everyone.

Yet, they have heard about Jesus, and know He can do something to heal them. Jesus gives them new life. He restores them. They are able to go and work, see their families and live in the town once again.

What is amazing about this story is that only one went back to Jesus to give Him thanks. All ten were healed, yet only one went back to Jesus. We are reminded in this true story, of being thankful. Jesus gives new life to all those who put their faith and trust in Him. He saves us from our sin. A saved heart is a thankful heart.






# Jesus Healed Ten Lepers Bible Craft


This fun handprint craft will help children remember the importance of thanking God for answered prayers.

You will need:

- Paint
- Paper
- Permanent marker
- Wipes for clean-up if necessary

Instructions:

Step 1. Give each child a piece of construction paper and instruct them to write or copy the words “Jesus Healed 10” on the top of the paper and the words “Only 1 Said Thank You” on the bottom of the paper (see image).




**Step 2. Assist children with covering both palms of their hands with washable paint. Allow the children to press their palms carefully onto the paper to create two clear handprints (see image).**



**Step 3. When the paint dries allow children to illustrate the tip of each finger to represent the 10 men. Instruct children to write the words, "Thank You!" along one of the fingers to show how one thanked Jesus (see image).**




