CORONAVIRUS

I'm sure we all had some sense of disappointment when the government announced the postponement to 'Freedom Day' last month. While that was difficult, we understand the caution being taken with the rapid increase in Delta variant cases. This has meant that we as a church have had to push back our plans.

Here is an update of our plans over the coming months:

- We continue as we have been doing during this year. Please continue to follow our guidelines and please continue to book for our Sunday service, if possible.
- From Sunday 25th July we will change the way we use our booking system. there will be two seating zones in the church building for our Sunday morning service. Zone one will be seating for those who are happy to sit with others without social distancing. Zone two will be for those who would like a social distanced seat. The hope is that this will provide a bridge from restrictions to no restrictions. So, from the 25th July, please book using the current system, if you would like a socially distanced seat at our morning service.
- As we approach the summer holidays, from the **18th July**, our morning services will be all age services. Our theme is 'Jesus Builds a Bigger Table.'
- It was great to have the band back playing at our last baptism service. During the coming months, we will have the band live twice a month, as we wait and long for that day when we can sing as God people once again.
- Junior Church is planning to return in September.

Thank you for your flexibility and understanding during this pandemic. It has been a challenge for us all, but there is some light at the end of the tunnel.

Once again, I would also like to thank those who have volunteered to clean the building after our Sunday morning worship. Without those volunteers we would not have been able to open.
