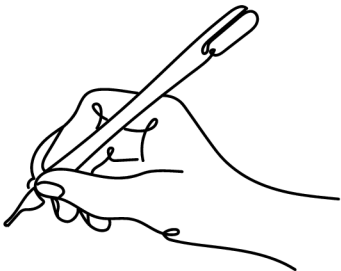

HOPE | EXPLORED

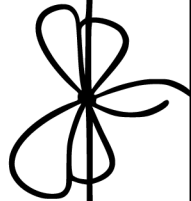
